### Upgrading Our Service to You—as a Lion

Namaste! The divine in me salutes the divine in you. Welcome to our new century. My goal over the next 12 months is very simple—to reach a new level of service to Lions and from Lions. Before I ask you to reach a new level of service, Lionism will reach a new level of service to you.

So how can I serve our 1.4 million Lions? I cannot give everyone senior positions. I cannot give you money. I cannot meet all of you. However, I plan to touch all of your lives with the power to serve.

So let's examine every stage of one's Lionistic career and how I can help. The first stage is becoming a new member. When I became a new member 43 years ago, I suddenly felt as if I had left my hometown and become a man of the world. This year, I want every member to download our new mobile app. This will connect all our members on one global platform.

The next stage is beginning to serve. As a member of the Batala Smile Lions Club in Punjab, India, I was proud of

how the community began to respect me. This respect depended on the number of people I served and how many people were aware of this service. We now have a new Global Service Team. Your District GST leader will identify projects that serve the maximum number of people per dollar and per hour. They will also train Lions on how to convert a normal project into a Legacy Project via Lions branding and public relations.

The third stage is aspiring for leadership. While I enjoyed rising up the Lions' ladder, I sometimes wished that our leaders focused more on work than on long speeches. A new awards system will incentivize the efforts of Lion leaders in the right direction. We plan to reward retention of members, hence keeping the focus on you—our existing members. New awards will also be given for involving over half the club in service and for creating the most Legacy projects.

As a global leader of Lionism, I want to keep every Lion connected to Lionism. Our new Welcome Home program is an international online club for members unable to attend club meetings. Meetings and fee payments are conducted entirely online.

The last stage is now. I want to give every Lion the same goal for the next 12 months. My dream is that every Lion will serve 10 people each month. If this happens, we will serve 170 million people this year— a big increase from our current level of 100 million and a big step toward our goal of serving 200 million annually by 2020. This is the focus of all my meetings around the world.



## Lions Clubs International History Timeline

1917: Association founded in Chicago, Illinois, USA on June 7 by businessman Melvin Jones.

1920: Association became international with the formation of the first club in Canada in Windsor Ontario.

1925: Helen Keller challenges the Lions to become her "knights of the blind in this crusade against darkness."

1931: First club in Latin America chartered.

1945: Association helps the Non-Government Organizations section of the United Nations.

1947: First club in Australia chartered.

1948: First club in Europe chartered.

1953: First club in Asia chartered. First club in Africa chartered.

1957: Leo Program created to provide the youth of the world with an opportunity for personal development through volunteering.

1968: Lions Clubs International Foundation "LCIF" was formed. This is the charitable arm of the Lions organization, carrying out essential humanitarian service projects.

1976: MD'A' District A-15 was formed on July 1st. The first Governor of A-15 was Dougald Campbell.

1983: Lions Foundation of Canada was created and has since expanded to six Dog Guides programs.

1987: Lions Clubs International becomes the first service club to admit women as members.

1990: Since the launch of SightFirst, Lions have raised more than \$346 million for this initiative. SightFirst targets the major causes of blindness.

1998: The Dog Guide Breeding & Training facility, located in Breslau Ontario, was officially opened.

2005: Campaign SightFirst II, LCIF's most ambitious fundraising campaign, kicks off at the International Convention. By 2008, Lions surpass the goal, raising more than US\$200 million.

2011: LCIF awards its 10,000th grant, bringing the total amount awarded to US\$708 million.

2014: Centennial Service Challenge –Lions Clubs International begins its centennial celebrations as it looks toward the centennial year, 2017. LCI pledges to benefit 100 million people through projects impacting youth, vision, hunger and the environment.

#### Judging:

- 2. The grading form will list each evaluation criterion. Judges will rank each submission by each evaluation criterion (i.e., all evaluation is comparative rather than absolute).
- 3. The overall score for each submission will be the sum of the evaluation criterion rankings.

- $4. \ \ All\ proceeds\ will\ be\ used\ for\ diabetes\ research\ in\ Canada.$
- Awards will be processed upon receipt of the \$800.00 contribution.

#### **Club Excellence Award**

To qualify the club must further the objectives of the association, adhere to the association's constitution and by-laws and policies, and meet each requirement noted below during the fiscal year.

**CLUB IN GOOD STANDING** – International per capita taxes and new member Entrance fees are paid in full and there is no outstanding balance of US\$50 or more that is (90) days or more past due.

**SERVICE** – The club must conduct at least three service projects. **CONTRIBUTION** –The club has either contributed a minimum of US\$10 for each club member to LCIF or awarded a Melvin Jones Fellow or progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.

**MEMBERSHIP** – the club achieved a net growth in membership (including branch club members when applicable) or sponsored a new club. The new members attended an orientation and were properly inducted into the Lions club.

**COMMUNICATION** – The club has publicized the club's service activities to the public through local media and effectively communicated activities to club members.

**LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT** – All officer positions were filled in accordance with the constitution and bylaws by qualified Lions, a majority of club officers participated in a leadership training program at the zone, district, multiple district or international level and the club was represented at zone meetings.

**CLUB DEVELOPMENT** – The club has hosted regular and meaningful club meetings and submitted the Monthly Membership Report, the Service Activity Report and the Club Officer Report (PU-101) in a timely manner.

A completed form (available on LCI web site) must be mailed to the English Language Department at International Headquarters, or faxed to (630) 706-9130, to arrive by September 30th.



The Lake Joseph Centre is one of the CNIB's most cherished programs dedicated to people of all ages who are blind, visually impaired and deaf blind.

Each summer, as many as 2,000 children, adults and seniors come to enjoy the cool waters, winding trails and campfires offered at the Centre. They learn to play basketball, swim, canoe and even water-ski. These are experiences most of us take for granted but are too often out of reach for people with serious visual impairments.

The only facility of its kind in Ontario, the Lake Joseph Centre represents much more than a tranquil summer getaway. Being able to participate in new and exciting challenges is extremely important for people who are blind, visually impaired and deaf blind. It builds their self confidence, gives them the strength and skill to face the many obstacles that block their path to independence.

During July and August, the Centre is reserved for guests who are blind, visually impaired and deaf blind. Not-for-profit groups such as senior's homes, hospitals, schools and other special interest groups are encouraged to rent the Centre during May, June and September.

The Lake Joseph Centre gives visually impaired, blind and deaf blind people the chance to experience things they've never experienced before and embrace life in a way they never thought possible.

The Lake Joseph Centre would like to thank Lions Clubs of Ontario Multiple District "A" for their dedication and support. We couldn't have done it without you. You can become a Knight of Lake Joe for a \$100.00 donation.

#### Honorary Lions Guardian of Camp Huronda

For a tax receipt-able donation of \$100.00 your name will be inscribed in a memorial book and displayed proudly at the Camp FOREVER. In addition you will receive a classic limited edition lapel pin and elegant certificate symbolizing your dedication and devotion towards the Camp's ongoing refurbishment and capital requirements campaign.

Camp Huronda was established in 1971, and is located on the shores of Lake Waseosa near Huntsville. Its Mission is "To provide a camping experience that fosters the life long well being of children with diabetes." The camp provides a camping program for boys and girls 8 to 15 years of age, with Type 1 diabetes. The Camp accommodates up to 90 children in each of four two-week sessions in July and August. Last year a total of 360 children experienced a summer adventure of fun, activities, new skills and health care at Camp Huronda. Unfortunately we had to turn away more than fifty children due to space limitations.

The Camp helps children share similar experiences with others, creates good habits and builds self-esteem. It is a camp where many children learn how to give themselves insulin injections for the first time as well as learn various injection sites and develop effective blood monitoring skills. Through various camp experiences, children learn how to manage their diabetes successfully, which contributes greatly to delaying and lowering the risks of complications.

Camp Huronda operations are dependent upon the support of foundations, service clubs, corporate and private donations.

The "Guardian of Camp Huronda" project was developed by the Lions at the request of the District A-12 Diabetes and Camp Huronda Chair and approved by MD "A" in order to help raise much needed dollars towards the Camp's ongoing requirement of \$50,000.00 annually for refurbishment and capital projects.

Contributions can be made to the Fellowship by individuals including non-Lions Club members, clubs, districts or multiple districts. Please allow 4-6 weeks for delivery.

# INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIPS & DIRECTORSHIPS

#### **Melvin Jones Fellowship**

The Melvin Jones Fellowship is recognition of a commitment to humanitarian work. (It is not an award in the tradition of Lions awards presented for specific accomplishments.) The fellowship is an honour given to individuals who contribute the equivalent of US\$1000 to LCIF, and persons for whom such donations are made by others. The fellowship is the foundation's highest honor and represents humanitarian qualities such as generosity, compassion, and concern for the less fortunate. Melvin Jones Fellows receive a lapel pin and a personalized wall plaque in honour of their commitment to helping others.

#### When did the fellowship originate?

Created in 1973, the fellowship is named for the founder of Lions Clubs International, Melvin Jones.

#### Is the fellowship for Lions only?

The fellowship is not limited to Lions clubs members. It is open to non-Lions to whom identical recognition is presented.

#### May the fellowship be presented posthumously?

Yes, the fellowship may be given in memory of a deceased individual. In those cases, the plaque is inscribed, "in memory of' and is presented to the individual named by the donor to receive them. (Often the plaque, pin and letter are presented to a close relative of the deceased.) When filling out the application, please provide all of the information requested for the person to whom the recognition will be presented (the family member). That information is required to prepare an appropriate letter for presentation with the plaque.

#### Who can contribute toward a Melvin Jones Fellowship?

Contributions can be made by individuals including non-Lions, Clubs, or Districts in one sum, or in installments of a minimum of US\$100 over a five-year period, but only individuals can receive fellowship recognition.

### Is it possible to make a donation and choose the MJF recipient later?

Yes. You must tell us that the donation is to be applied toward an unnamed fellowship at the time it is sent in. Complete the yellow Melvin Jones Fellowship application (LCIF-42) or the application on the Melvin Jones Fellowship brochure (LCIF-24) available in PDF format.

Write "Melvin Jones Fellow to be named later on the cheque or bank draft".

When an individual's or group of individuals' personal donation(s) are accumulated for a club's use to select a Melvin Jones Fellowship recipient, we require documentation of the consent of the original donor(s) in writing, signed by each individual. When a club's donation(s) are accumulated for a fellowship recipient to be selected by the district, LCIF requires signed documentation of the consent of the club. Please include such documentation with the Completed MJF application that is sent to LCIF Donor & Financial Services.

## **LCI Life Membership**

#### Criteria:

- Any member of a Club who has maintained Active membership as a Lion for 20 or more years and has rendered outstanding service to his/her Club, his/her community, or the International Association of Lions Clubs;
- 2. OR any member who is critically ill;
- 3. OR any member of a Club who has maintained such active membership for 15 or more years and is at least 70 years of age.

#### Requirements:

- 1. Recommendation of his/her Club to the Association,
- 2. Payment to the Association of US\$650.00, or its equivalent in the respective national currency, by his/her Club in lieu of all future dues to the Association, and
- 3. Approval by the International Board of Directors. Nothing herein shall prevent his/her Club from charging a Life Member such dues as it shall deem proper.

A Life Member shall have all privileges of active membership so long as he/she fulfills all obligations thereof.

A Life Member who desires to relocate and receives an invitation to join another Lions Club shall automatically become a Life Member of said Club.

#### LIONS EYE GLASS RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

Revised June 2016

Clerc accepts the following eyeglasses - Reading, Single Vision, Bifocal, Children, Safety, non-prescription Sunglasses New and Used.

Please send both plastic and metal frames. Remove eyeglass cases, loose and broken lenses or damaged lenses and frames before shipping. Rather than storing glasses for a long time, send as soon as possible to the Lion Eyeglass Recycling Center. Time, extreme temperature and weather conditions cause damage to frames and lenses, often rendering them useless.

Pack eyeglasses in a sturdy corrugated box. Layer rows of eyeglasses with tissue paper, newspaper or styrofoam. Please avoid using shredded packing materials or Styrofoam "peanuts." Seal box with tape. Be sure label is legible and Include your return address. All glasses from Ontario and East are now shipped to Montreal.

For clubs in District A15, the following option is available for shipping:

## **Official Colors**

Purple and gold were chosen when the association was founded in 1917. The purple represents loyalty to country, friends, to one's self and to the integrity of mind and heart. It is the color of strength, courage and dedication to a cause. Gold symbolizes sincerity of purpose, liberality in judgment, purity in life and generosity in mind, heart and commitment to mankind. Often, a dark blue is used in place of the purple.

#### Official Emblem

The current Lion emblem (or logo) was adopted at the 1919 convention. Today, Lions worldwide are recognized by it. It consists of a gold letter "L" on a circular purple (or blue) field. Bordering this is a circular gold area with two Lion profiles facing away from the centre. The Lions face both past and future - showing both pride of heritage and confidence in the future. The word "Lions" appears at the top, and "International" at the bottom.

Always wear your Lions emblem pin proudly. And remember, since it is a registered trademark in most countries, it may never be used for commercial or fundraising purposes without prior permission from the Legal Division at International Headquarters.

# International Fellowship and Understanding

It may appear that the language barrier would make international understanding almost impossible. But international understanding and friendship (or fellowship) is a matter of spirit rather than language. Lions throughout the world communicate with one another through club activities that create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world.
