These are the Elements of Excellence:**

1. Service -Complete three service projects

2. Donate to LCIF

3. Membership Development -Have a net increase of one member OR Charter a new Lion, Leo or Branch Club

4. Officers -participate in one or more leadership training events. District, Multiple District, International, Webinars, Lions Learning Centre or Club Quality Initiative. Must improve Club Operations.

5. Marketing and Communication - The club has publicized its service activities through local media or Social Media, or the Club used Social Media to promote Club activities as noted.

6. Club Maintains Good Standing - To fully participate in Lions activity, your club must be in good standing at the end of the fiscal year. To be in good standing the club cannot be in status quo and all International dues billings and new member entrance fees need to be paid in full. No more than US\$50 in any other expense due to LCI can be outstanding beyond ninety (90) days

A completed form (<http://www.lionsclubs.org/resources/108253958>) must be mailed to the English Language Department at International Headquarters, or faxed to (630) 468-6828, to arrive by August 31. The application form can also be emailed to the District Governor for the year being submitted and they can submit the form directly. If mailed or faxed, the District Governor must sign the form. If sent from District Governor's email, it qualifies as signature on applications submitted electronically. This award will be mailed to the next year's District Governor for presentation.

Criteria for the Club Excellence award changes frequently. To ensure that you have the latest application please go to the link on the A15 website or to MyLCI. Application deadlines are August 31 for the previous Lion's year.

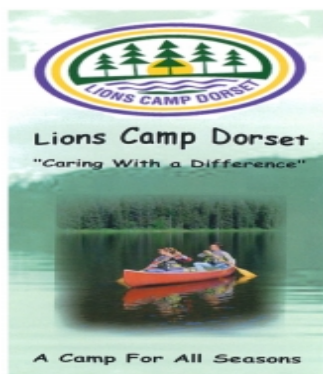

Lions Code of Ethics

To Show my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that I may merit a reputation for quality of service.

To Seek success and to demand all fair remuneration or profit as my just due, but to accept no profit or success at the price of my own self-respect lost because of unfair advantage taken or because of questionable acts on my part.

To Remember that in building up my business it is not necessary to tear down another's; to be loyal to my clients or customers and true to myself. Whenever a doubt arises as to the right or ethics of my position or action towards others, to resolve such doubts against myself.

To Hold friendship as an end and not a means. To hold that true friendship exists not on account of the service performed by one another, but that true friendship demands nothing but accepts service in the spirit in which it is given. Always to bear in mind my obligations as a citizen to my nation, my state, and my community, and to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act, and deed. To give them freely of my time, labor and means.

To Aid others by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak, and my substance to the needy.

To Be Careful with my criticism and liberal with my praise; to build up and not destroy.

Lions International Purposes

To Organize, charter and supervise service clubs to be known as Lions clubs.

To Coordinate the activities and standardize the administration of Lions clubs.

To Create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world.

To Promote the principles of good government and good citizenship.

To Take an active interest in the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community.

To Unite the clubs in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding.

To Provide a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest; provided, however, that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by club members.

To Encourage service-minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavors.

Official Colors

Purple and gold were chosen when the association was founded in 1917. The purple represents loyalty to country, friends, to one's self and to the integrity of mind and heart. It is the color of strength, courage and dedication to a cause. Gold symbolizes sincerity of purpose, liberality in judgment, purity in life and generosity in mind, heart and commitment to mankind. Often, a dark blue is used in place of the purple.

Official Emblem

The current Lion emblem (or logo) was adopted at the 1919 convention. Today, Lions worldwide are recognized by it. It consists of a gold letter "L" on a circular purple (or blue) field. Bordering this is a circular gold area with two Lion profiles facing away from the centre. The Lions face both past and future - showing both pride of heritage and confidence in the future. The word "Lions" appears at the top, and "International" at the bottom. Always wear your Lions emblem pin proudly. And remember, since it is a registered trademark in most countries, it may never be used for commercial or fundraising purposes without prior permission from the Legal Division at International Headquarters.

International Fellowship and Understanding

It may appear that the language barrier would make international understanding almost impossible. But international understanding and friendship (or fellowship) is a matter of spirit rather than language. Lions throughout the world communicate with one another through club activities that create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world.
