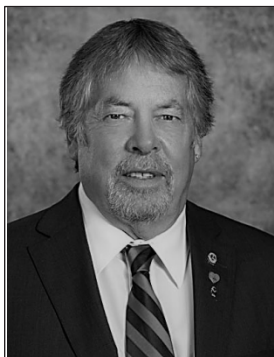

The fellowship is an honour given to individuals who contribute the equivalent of US\$1000 to LCIF, and persons for whom such donations are made by others.

The fellowship is the foundation's highest honor and represents humanitarian qualities such as generosity, compassion, and concern for the less fortunate. Melvin Jones Fellows receive a lapel pin and a personalized wall plaque in honour of their commitment to helping others.

## **LCI Club Excellence Award:**

To qualify the club must further the objectives of the association, adhere to the association's constitution and by-laws and policies, and meet requirement in areas noted below during the Lions fiscal year.

**CLUB IN GOOD STANDING** – International per capita taxes and new member Entrance fees are paid in full and there is no outstanding balance of US\$50 or more that is (90) days or more past due.

**SERVICE** – The club must conduct at least three service projects in the Fiscal year.

**CONTRIBUTION** –The club has either contributed a minimum of US\$10 for each club member to LCIF or awarded a Melvin Jones Fellow or progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.

**MEMBERSHIP** – the club achieved a net growth in membership (including branch club members when applicable) or sponsored a new club. The new members attended an orientation and were properly inducted into the Lions club.

**COMMUNICATION** – The club has publicized the club's service activities to the public through local media and effectively communicated activities to club members.

# Lions Code of Ethics

**To Show** my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that I may merit a reputation for quality of service.

**To Seek** success and to demand all fair remuneration or profit as my just due, but to accept no profit or success at the price of my own self-respect lost because of unfair advantage taken or because of questionable acts on my part.

**To Remember** that in building up my business it is not necessary to tear down another's; to be loyal to my clients or customers and true to myself. Whenever a doubt arises as to the right or ethics of my position or action towards others, to resolve such doubts against myself.

**To Hold** friendship as an end and not a means. To hold that true friendship exists not on account of the service performed by one another, but that true friendship demands nothing but accepts service in the spirit in which it is given. Always to bear in mind my obligations as a citizen to my nation, my state, and my community, and to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act, and deed. To give them freely of my time, labor and means.

**To Aid** others by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak, and my substance to the needy.

**To Be Careful** with my criticism and liberal with my praise; to build up and not destroy.

## **Lions International Purposes**

**To Organize**, charter and supervise service clubs to be known as Lions clubs.

**To Coordinate** the activities and standardize the administration of Lions clubs.

**To Create** and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world.

**To Promote** the principles of good government and good citizenship.

**To Take** an active interest in the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community.

**To Unite** the clubs in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding.

**To Provide** a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest; provided, however, that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by club members.

**To Encourage** service-minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavors.

## **Official Colors**

Purple and gold were chosen when the association was founded in 1917. The purple represents loyalty to country, friends, to one's self and to the integrity of mind and heart. It is the color of strength, courage and dedication to a cause. Gold symbolizes sincerity of purpose, liberality in judgment, purity in life and generosity in mind, heart and commitment to mankind. Often, a dark blue is used in place of the purple.

## **Official Emblem**

The current Lion emblem (or logo) was adopted at the 1919 convention. Today, Lions worldwide are recognized by it. It consists of a gold letter "L" on a circular purple (or blue) field. Bordering this is a circular gold area with two Lion profiles facing away from the centre. The Lions face both past and future - showing both pride of heritage and confidence in the future. The word "Lions" appears at the top, and "International" at the bottom. Always wear your Lions emblem pin proudly. And remember, since it is a registered trademark in most countries, it may never be used for commercial or fundraising purposes without prior permission from the Legal Division at International Headquarters.

## **International Fellowship and Understanding**

It may appear that the language barrier would make international understanding almost impossible. But international understanding and friendship (or fellowship) is a matter of spirit rather than language. Lions throughout the world communicate with one another through club activities that create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world.
