Dr. Patti Hill from Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, was elected to serve as international president of Lions Clubs International at the association's 105th International Convention, July 7 through July 11, 2023.

International President Hill is the president of a consulting firm that helps government agencies design and implement effective programs for children and youth with unique needs. With 30 years of experience as an educator and psychologist, she has mentored graduate students and psychologists in training, and worked to improve education for young people who are deaf.

"The purpose of my life is to help others achieve their potential," said Dr. Hill. "I believe we're here to make the world a better place for all."

In her role as international president, Dr. Hill will support the service of Lions around the world, who served over 500 million people in 2022-2023. She will also oversee the launch of MISSION 1.5, a global membership growth initiative designed to empower local clubs to welcome new Lions and Leos in our mission of serving a world in need.

To help meet the growing needs of our communities, President Hill is encouraging clubs to undertake big, ambitious service projects and support the Lions Clubs International Foundation so that Lions can increase their local and global impact.

President Hill's message for the year is "Changing the World," which reminds us that every act of service, no matter how small, brings us one step closer to making the world a better place.

"Global challenges may seem daunting, but there is always a place where we can begin," said President Hill. "When we strive to make positive changes—in our lives and the lives of others—we put good into the world."

Our Lions International President Dr. Patti Hill’s message is “Changing the World”. How do we change the world? Well, we do it one step at a time.

In 2019 Nancy and I spent a memorable week helping out at the Monkton Lions Kids Outdoors & Fishing camp. One of the responsibilities that PDG Tim gave me was to oversee the kids that were taking part in activities on the dock. I had to make sure that they had their life jackets on, bait their hooks if they were fishing, etc. Most of these young campers were more interested in swimming or doing crafts, except for one young fellow who wanted to fish. He had never fished before. If allowed, he would have fished morning, noon and night. I enjoyed sitting on the dock watching him spend his entire time casting, catching fish and releasing them. When he went home at the end of the week, he was given a fishing rod and a tackle box full of tackle by the camp. I don’t remember his name or know what he is doing in his teen years, but I am sure he is still fishing. We Lions changed this young person’s life. The members of the Monkton Lions created the fishing camp, and a Lions club sponsored that boy. This is a great example of how Lions can change the world one person at a time.

How many more boys and girls are out there waiting for a chance to be shown how to fish on the docks? How many more members of our communities could we help if we had more members? We know that service projects with a high community profile and that also involve all Club members generally result in increased membership, “Service with a Purpose”.

I am asking each club to add 3 new service projects this year. Collectively, that means we could add 171 new service projects. Can we do it? Absolutely! The primary purpose of your District leaders is to support your Clubs. We have a great team of Zone Chairs, Region Chairs and GAT Team ready and excited to work with you and also lead by example.

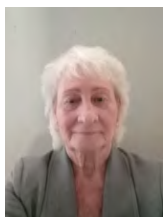

To Hold friendship as an end and not a means. To hold that true friendship exists not on account of the service performed by one another, but that true friendship demands nothing but accepts service in the spirit in which it is given. Always to bear in mind my obligations as a citizen to my nation, my state, and my community, and to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act, and deed. To give them freely of my time, labor and means.

To Aid others by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak, and my substance to the needy.

To Be Careful with my criticism and liberal with my praise; to build up and not destroy.

To Create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world.

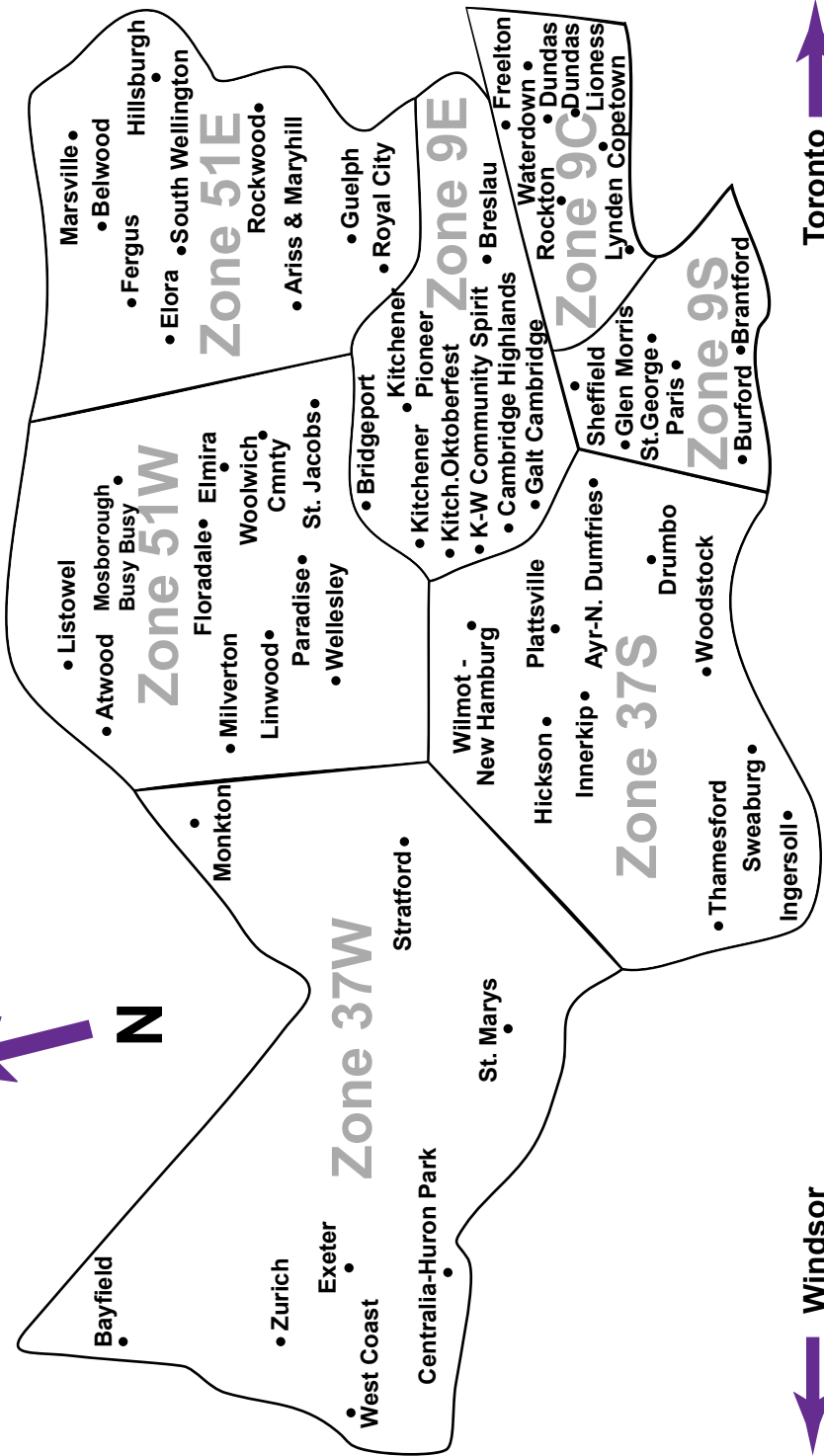
To Promote the principles of good government and good citizenship.

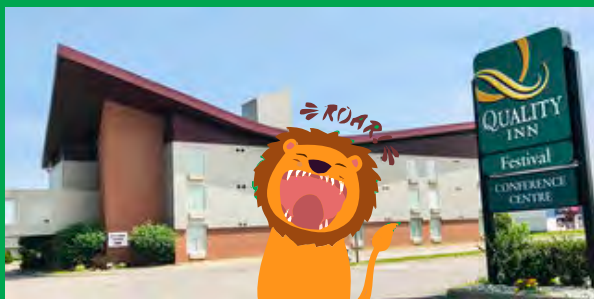
