



This year's "Ride for Dog Guides" will be held Saturday, June 21st, 2014.

Last year the Guelph LIONS Club took part by hosting one of the stops. The riders had a washroom break and food and drink was supplied by our Club. Our LION, Charlene Teasdale, was involved with planning of this ride and is again this year on the LFC planning committee.
