Gatekeeper named for recent OK'd district police checks policy

Lions

The system for District program Police Check requests as required by the A15 Volunteer Screening Police Check Policy 2014 OR for clubs or individuals choosing to use this system has now been put in place.

Should you wish to request a police check done using this system you must contact; PDDG George Patton District Police Check Gatekeeper <u>policecheckkeeper@a15lions.org</u> with the name, address and email contact for the individual requiring the check. A standard Criminal Record Checks (\$29+HST) will be done.

Police checks requested through this service for other than a District Program will be invoiced to the candidate (or club).

If someone wants an Enhanced Police Information Check, the candidate (or club) will be billed for the difference (\$34 + HST - \$29 +HST = \$38.42 - \$32.77= \$5.65.
