
1985 SWEABURG & DISTRICT LIONS CLUB CHARTER PIN







The Sweaburg & District Lions charter pin was dedicated to the memory of Captain Thomas Williams, as told by Lion Rick Bell (Jan, 2020) - "Tommy Williams was a resident of Sweaburg, a rather famous one. He joined the Royal Air Force during the First World War. He went on to become a flying Ace. He was awarded the Military Cross for his efforts. He continued flying after the war "barnstorming around the province. He used to fly from his property, just north of the village. He even crashed into a neighbour's apple orchard. I believe that he was still flying when he was eighty."
